Sugarloaf School

The **Sugarloaf School** is a school located east of Jerome, <u>Idaho</u> that was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1983. It was built in 1924 by master stonemason <u>H.T. Pugh</u> who popularized the use of lava rock in the Jerome area. [1]
