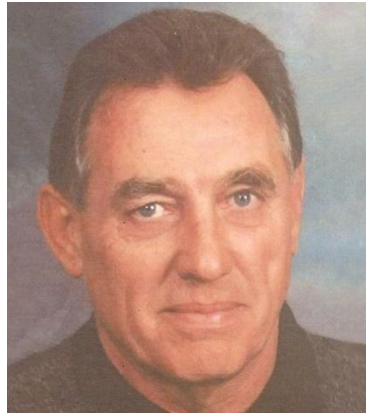


Melvin Eddie Keyes
